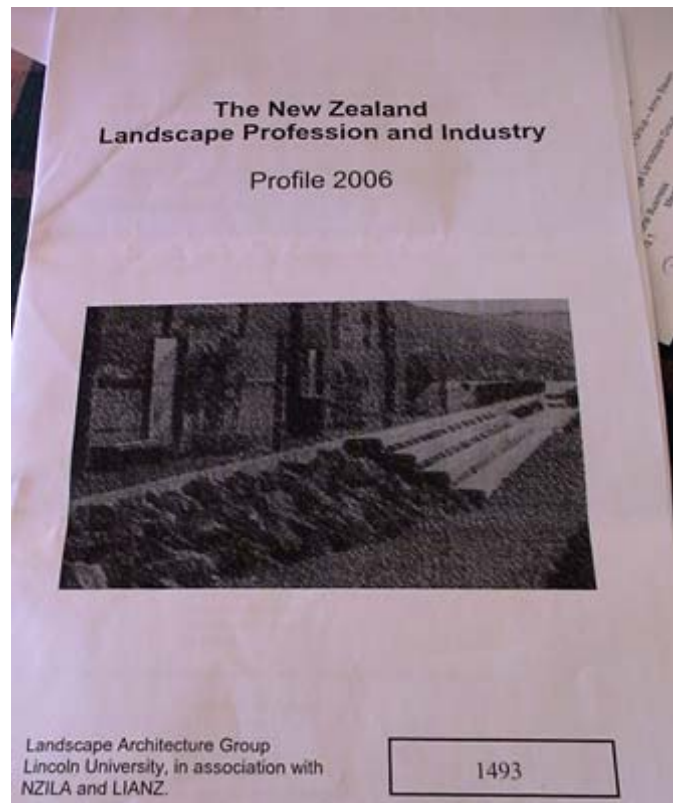


The New Zealand Landscape Profession and Industry Survey – 2006

The NZILA is pleased to provide some initial results from the questionnaire distributed to members in January and February this year, covering a range of information from the previous year. While a full analysis and interpretation of the results is some way off, the executive committee thought that a simple count of the responses to some of the variables would be of interest to members.

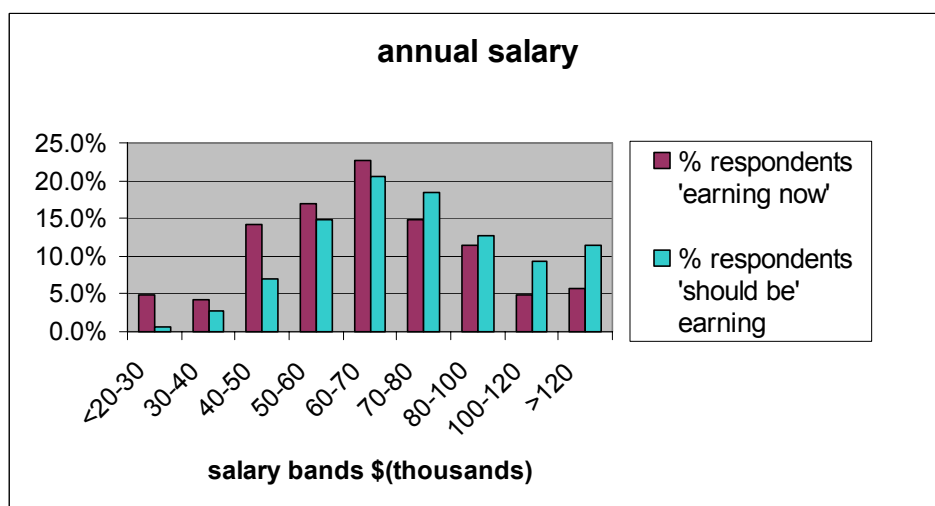
More than 150 members completed a questionnaire, giving a final response rate of almost 30%, less than was hoped for, but enough to give us a good current profile of the profession. (The percentage figures in the following charts and lists are proportions of those who responded, not proportions of the Institute membership as a whole.)

Please note that the research protocol provides for a minimum number of five respondents to be present in a category for it to be disaggregated, to preserve anonymity. Where fewer than five are present in any category, they are added to adjacent categories until the minimum number is met.

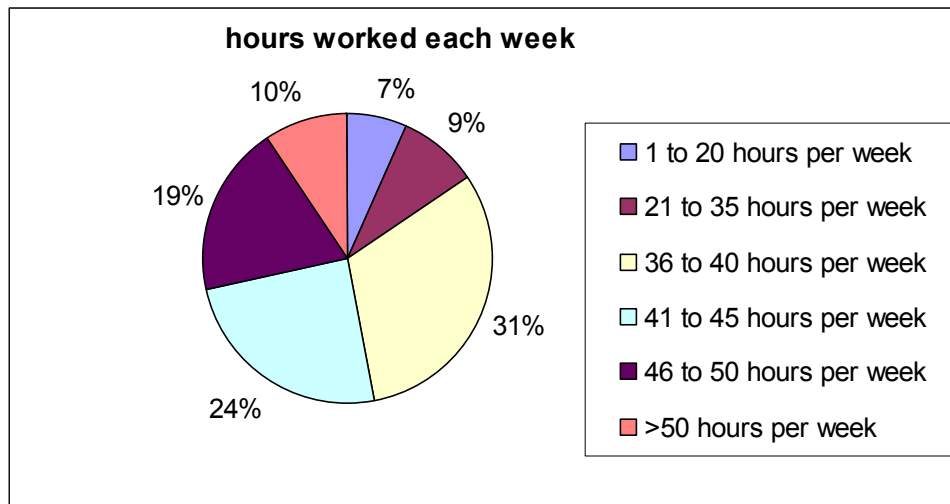


The committee thanks all of those members who responded, and looks forward to progressively releasing further results as they come to hand.

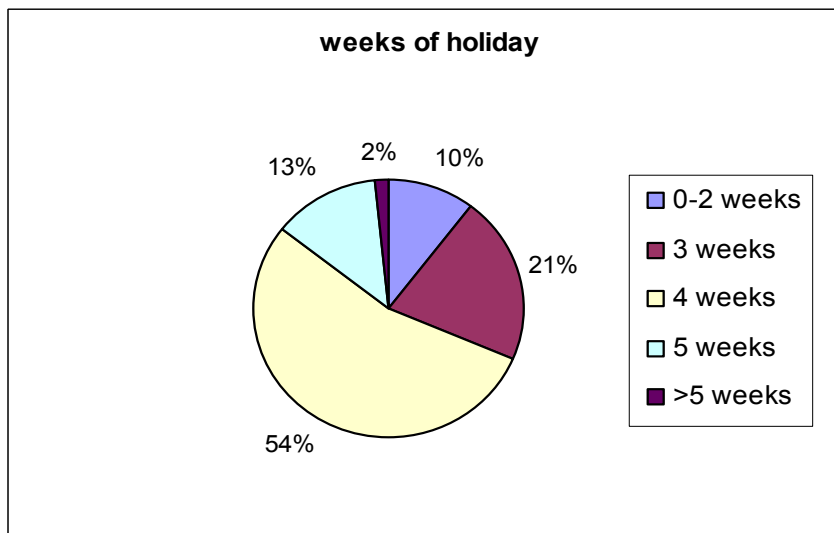
Actual and Desired Salary Bands
