A Landscape Architect shapes the word around us, designing and creating new landscapes - urban, rural, residential or public spaces as well as implementing strategies for the management and conservation of natural and heritage landscapes.

They have a passion for the landscape, both for its care, and its enhancement by design. The Landscape Architecture profession combines art and science, vision and thought and strategic planning and creativeness.

Who do landscape architects work with?

Landscape Architects are employed in private and public organisations:

- Private sector opportunities are found within landscape architectural, engineering, architectural and planning firms
- Public sector employment opportunities are found within regional, and local councils involved in land planning, development and preservation.

Often Landscape Architects collaborate with other consultants to find solutions and create environmental outcomes that benefit the community, economy and the surrounding landscape.

- Lawyers
